



Cape Fear Literacy Council based in Wilmington received a 2009 Ribbon of Hope grant to provide targeted computer-based and small-class instruction to 75 new or current adult learners from the low-income, immigrant, minority, under/unemployed, and low-level educated populations in New Hanover County.
