This Ribbon of Hope grant supported the “Wonders of the World” science education project for all students in grades 3-12, impacting 10,897 students in Craven County Schools. The project includes 40 rock and mineral, river sediments, and wind and hydropower kits, Wireless Weather Stations to record, compare and contrast weather data locally and around the world, and on-site presentations and activities by the North Carolina Aquarium. By integrating hands-on science activities in the classroom students and teachers will have the necessary tools to build a strong STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Math) foundation which is essential in creating a 21st Century learning environment.
