The [Coastal Federation's](#) "Coastal Habitat Education Program" five year grant will engage thousands of adults and children in environmental education and hands-on restoration activities that will help them become better stewards of North Carolina's coastal resources. Environmental science awareness efforts and projects include: water quality, creating stormwater gardens, shellfish habitat restoration, planting native plant habitats, oyster shell estuarine shoreline restoration, and other activities. The grant provided access to over 3,000 students and their teachers. This \$224,500 science education traditional grant reached high school, middle school and elementary school students from 2008 – 2012.
