

Expanding Horizons is a collaborative science project led by Communities In Schools of Brunswick County, Inc., with partners including: Mad Science of Coastal Carolina, The Ingram Planetarium, the Museum of Coastal Carolina and Bald Head Island Conservancy. The science project served 100 children currently enrolled in CIS after school programs and come from diverse ethnic, racial and socio-economic backgrounds. Handson science activities, exhibits, and demonstrations with imaginative learning, planetary and astronomy activities are the tools used for delivery. Students from grades three, four and five will learn how to become stewards of the community's rich surroundings of dunes, sea life and marshes. Expanding Horizons is aimed at widening a child's horizons to look beyond their sometimes limited life experiences.
