

A math intervention program that recruits, trains, and supports volunteers to work as tutors in high-poverty elementary schools. Teachers in Title I elementary schools recommend students in grades 1 – 5 to receive one-on-one instruction during the school day. Community members commit one hour per week to deliver the curriculum and receive on-site support from a Heart staff person (Program Coordinator). The proposed activities involve direct costs of expanding the program to a new school site, where 50 students would receive tutoring for 30 minutes twice per week.
